**RE: Beaver Creek Lift Station Improvements
(Along US Hwy 18 between Beaver Creek and Blair Street)**

Dear Resident:

This letter is to inform you that the City's contractor hired to complete the above referenced project intends to begin work on the project during the week of June 12, 2014.

The project includes replacing the existing Beaver Creek lift station which is generally located immediately adjacent to the south side of US Hwy 18 and on the east side of Beaver Creek. The City's contractor will also be installing a new sanitary sewer force main from the lift station east to the parking lot of the City's ball field. A new sanitary sewer main will be installed in the existing alley between Blair Street and Howard Street and across the parking lot of the ball field.

The Contractor will begin the work on the east end of the project which is the intersection of Blair Street and the alley, just south of US Hwy 18. From that starting point, the Contractor will install new sanitary sewer main to the west.

Blair Street will be closed to thru-traffic at the alley while work is being completed in the intersection.

A construction bulletin for the project will be prepared periodically to update residents of the construction. The bulletin contains contact information for the contractor, City and engineer along with a status of the ongoing construction work. If you would like to receive these bulletins during construction, email me at mkadam.jsa@midconetwork.com.

Overall, the contractor has until October 10, 2014 to finish the construction work. This date may change due to the weather or unforeseen construction items.
