

### Canton's Beaver Creek Sanitary Lift Station

is in need of replacement. The City has initiated this construction project in order to replace and update the lift station. Work will also include updating and replacing the underground utilities on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from Main Street to the cul-de-sac.

### H&W Contracting from Sioux Falls, South Dakota

will be the contractor for this project. The contractor anticipates starting the project on **Friday, May 2, 2014**. Work will begin on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, beginning at the intersection of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and Main Street and progress towards the cul-de-sac to the West. Work on 5<sup>th</sup> Street will begin at a later date, yet to be determined.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Street will be closed to traffic during construction.** Traffic control signs will be installed a day or so in advance of the work. Vehicles parked within the work area when work begins will be towed at the Owner's expense.

The contractor expects to be completed with the project by October 10, 2014. **This is only an estimate and may vary due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.**

**This project generally consists of installing** a new lift station, force main, sanitary sewer pipe, watermain, storm sewer, and new asphalt pavement. You will be informed in person or with a note on your door approximately 1 day in advance of any scheduled interruption of your water and sewer service.

**If you have a disability or limitation** which may require special accommodations for access, please contact the JSA office. This project bulletin will be distributed by email every two weeks during construction, and will be posted on the City's website.
