The City of Canton's **Utility Contractor Digging Permit Rules & Agreement** shall be completed by the applicant and be attached to this Private Utility Permit with the appropriate permit fee.

I, the undersigned, request permission to construct and maintain a utility facility on public right-of-way at the locations shown on the attached construction plan and in accordance with any provisions and conditions attached to the project agree to abide by all said rules, conditions, and in addition, the following:

1. To restore any damaged portions of the roadway and right-of-way to equal or better conditions that existed prior to beginning work covered by this permit, including property pins and their correct location.
2. To maintain areas that are disturbed as a result of this project for one year after completion of the project (repair of any landscaped areas, washouts, settled trenches, pavement, sidewalk and/or driveway damage due to settled trenches, etc).
3. To provide protection to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction and maintenance by the use of proper signs, barricades, flag persons, and lights as prescribed in the most current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
4. To indemnify, hold and save harmless the City of Canton and its employees, for any and all suits, actions or claims of any kind or nature brought because of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person or property on account of the use or occupancy of public right-of-way designated in this application.

Failure to construct and maintain the utility in accordance with the provisions of this permit will automatically render this permit null and void and constitute grounds for the utility's removal and/or full restoration of the site at the applicant's expense.

Utility Contractor Digging Permit Rules & Agreement

- Utilities shall be buried at a depth of 36 inches plus or minus 2 inches.
- No more than 3 blocks of locates to be requested per working day of the project.
- If a City utility is damaged, it will be repaired by a licensed and insured contractor before the project work continues. The repair will occur at the sole expense of the project utility company. Name of company contracted to do repair work: _____.
- One person (i.e. foreman) will be designated to be available during working hours.

- No weekend or holiday work permitted.
- Set of as-built plans will be placed on file at City Hall.
- Bond in the amount of the total cost of the job will be on file with the City prior to start of construction and remain on file for 24 months after the job is complete.
- Back fill in the streets or under sidewalk will be a granular material.
- Contractor must provide own traffic control and barricades.
- Street and sidewalk repairs will be of same material as before work began and according to City Engineer's Design Standards.
- Any work may be stopped at any time by any city employee if contractor fails to comply with any these rules or ordinances of the City of Canton until resolution is agreed upon by both parties.
