Notices

- Contractor Insurance and Surety Bond needs to be on file before City will issue a permit.
- All work shall be completed in accordance with City Ordinances and City Engineering Design Standards including Standard Specifications and Details. All work not in conformance with these standards shall be immediately repaired or replaced.
- Sidewalk Width – 5' (exceptions may be granted if existing sidewalk is narrower)
- Sidewalk minimum thickness shall be 4 inches.
- Shall be 6 inches where the sidewalk is adjacent to the curb or at driveway approaches.
- The area within the street right-of-way shall be cleaned up to the satisfaction of the Public Works Director immediately following completion of the work.
- It is the Contractor's responsibility to contact **SD One-Call (811)** prior to performing any work.
