

2020 Swimming Pool

1. If you, or your child, is sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, you, or your child, will not be able to utilize our facilities until recovered. This is the responsibility of the parents and children to be accountable and stay safe.
2. We will not be accepting cash or checks at the pool this season. You MUST purchase a pool pass at City Hall before arriving at the pool. We will not be selling day passes at the facility. Season passes will be \$70 for family and \$30 for single. A waiver will be required.
3. The Canton swimming pool will be available ONLY to Canton citizens or families of the Canton School District. You may be asked to provide proof of residency when purchasing your pool pass.
4. We will be providing private lessons only to Canton citizens or students of the Canton School District. Lessons will only be held for those in levels 2-6. Limited spots will be available. Sign up at City Hall. Cost is \$45.
5. We will NOT be providing deck chairs for patrons to utilize throughout the day. You are welcome to bring your own lawn chair, towel, or blanket.
6. Our hours have changed to 12:00 pm – 6:00 pm, Monday-Sunday. Hours are subject to change, based on lifeguard availability. The baby pool will not be open. We will be limiting the number of patrons to 100 at any given time.
7. The locker room facilities will be closed. We will have 1 bathroom facility (in each side of the bathhouse) that patrons can utilize that will be cleaned multiple times throughout the day. Patrons will enter through the bathhouse and exit through the baby pool gate.
8. We will NOT have a concession stand this year. Water bottles and beverages are welcomed, but we ask that you do not bring food products. Glass bottles are prohibited.
9. We will NOT be renting toys, goggles, or baskets this year, but you are welcome to bring your own.
10. There will NOT be floatie Friday's, pool parties or adult swim.
