**ANY CONTRACTOR HAULING IN 5 OR MORE SEMI-LOADS (OR EQUIVALENT TO 5 SEMI-LOADS) MUST PUSH DEBRIS OVER THE EDGE OF BANK THEMSELVES.**

PAINTS & THEIR CONTAINERS (UNLESS CANS ARE OPENED AND CONTENTS ARE COMPLETELY DRIED)

ELECTRONICS (LARGE electronics devices: desktop and laptop personal computers, monitors, mainframe computers, battery backup uninterruptible power supplies, printers, scanners, copy machines, fax machines, microwave, television, video cassette recorders, laser disc players, digital video disc players, and stereo receivers. HANDHELD electronics devices: cell phones, pagers, personal digital assistants, video games, calculators, small MP3 players, small compact disc players, small cassette players, small radios, small walkie-talkies, and digital and electronic cameras.

## **ALL LOADS MUST BE SECURED – TARPED OR TIED**

### **DESIGNATED DUMPING AREAS**

**GRASS AND LEAVES:** THIS AREA IS FREE OF CHARGE. ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED FROM PLASTIC BAGS OR OTHER CONTAINERS AND BAGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE RUBBLE SITE. GARDEN WASTE AND SMALL WEEDS MAY BE DISPOSED OF IN THIS AREA. NO BRANCHES, PAPER OR OTHER DEBRIS MAY BE MIXED IN THE AREA.

**CARPET & SHINGLES:** CARPET, LINOLEUM, SHINGLES, FIBERGLASS, TARPAPER, FOAM INSULATION AND PVC PIPE MAY BE DISPOSED OF IN THIS AREA.

**TIN PILE:** THIS AREA IS DESIGNATED FOR ROOFING TIN, RAINDPOUTS, METAL CABINETS, STEEL CHAIR FRAMES, RODS, ETC. ANY WOOD MUST BE REMOVED.

**WIRE FENCING PILE:** THIS AREA IS FOR WIRE FENCING ONLY. (NO WOOD ALLOWED).

**WHITE GOODS:** COOKING STOVES, WASHERS, DRYERS, WATER SOFTENERS, HUMIDIFIERS, AND DISHWASHERS. (THERE WILL BE PER ITEM CHARGES FOR DISPOSAL).

**REFRIGERATORS:** THIS AREA IS FOR REFRIGERATORS, AIR CONDITIONERS, FREEZERS, DEHUMIDIFIERS AND APPLIANCES (ANYTHING THAT WAS MANUFACTURED WITH FREON). (THERE WILL BE PER ITEM CHARGES FOR DISPOSAL).

**RECYCLE WOOD PILE:** TREES, LARGE BRANCHES AND BUSHES. (WOOD WITHOUT ANY WIRE, METAL OR NON-WOOD DEBRIS)

**CONCRETE & DIRT:** CONCRETE, DIRT, ROCK, GRAVEL AND BRICK MAY BE DISPOSED OF IN THIS AREA.

**ASPHALT:** THIS AREA IS FOR ASPHALT.

**TIRES:** THERE IS A SPECIFIED AREA FOR TIRE DISPOSAL. (Fee per tire based on size)

**CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:** PLASTER, SHEETROCK...
